I originally thought that I would pursue estate planning, but between loving my property law class, and having a great co-op experience at Bowditch & Dewey (into which my Dad's firm Sheridan, Garrahan & Lander had merged in the 1980s), I decided to accept a job in the Real Estate and Environmental Practice Area – joining its MetroWest Permitting Group.
