Brigid Harrington Served on the Boston Bar Association's "Higher Education Legal Conference" Advisory Committee

The "Higher Education Legal Conference," which highlights the complex legal needs of higher education institutions, returned to an in-person format this year. Hosted by the Boston Bar Association on April 28, the conference was spearheaded by a seven-person advisory committee. A member of the advisory committee, Brigid Harrington helped shape the agenda for the event and moderated the session "Mental Health on Campus."
