Banker & Tradesman Publishes “MassDEP Should Run The NPDES Program” by Bob Cox

Banker & Tradesman published an article by [Bob Cox](#) on February 29 supporting MassDEP’s effort to assume responsibility for the wastewater discharge permitting process in Massachusetts. As Bob notes, the time is ripe – and long overdue – for MassDEP to take delegation from EPA of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) program. Due to its focus on environmental issues specific to the state, MassDEP will administer a more efficient NPDES program than the nationally-focused EPA.
