Under the tax bill, the amount you can leave tax-free to heirs is a generous \$11.2 million in some states. However, in other states, that tax is “portable,” meaning a couple could potentially double that amount. Shoro commented on the federal tax exemption in terms of Massachusetts and where it falls on that spectrum, calling it a “use it or lose it exemption.”
